School Assembly

The School conducts morning assembly daily. Students and staff take part in prayer and community songs. Students stand according to their house in different colours to represent their houses. Music teachers and PTI pay their special attention during the morning assembly.

General Rules

- Parents are expected to co-operate with the school authorities in maintaining regularity discipline and punctuality and to see that their wards take on active interest in all the activities of the school.
- Parents are expected to see the cleanliness and civic manners of their wards.
- Occasional reports and recommendation from the principal and the teachers are made in the school diary. Parents are requested to sign them.
- Parents, Guardians or tutors are not permitted to visit the classes or meet the teachers without the prior permission of the principal
- Parents should arrange to take their children home within 15minutes after the school is over. the school will not be responsible, it the children are not fetched within 15 minutes.
- An application from the parents for the leave of absence must be sent in advance or latest within a week. Absence without leave will lead to "striking off" the name of the absentee from the rolls at the end of the month.
- Parents are required to notify the school of any change in their address / telephone no.





Library (5000+)

Various magazines, journals and books written by eminent personalities and authors have been introduced in the school libraries to keep the teachers and students update with current information and knowledge. Library periods have been introduced from Class 1st onwards. The library is affluent with autobiographies, fictions, diversified reference and informative books touching all related fields.

Teaching through Digital Classes

With the introduction of teaching through digital Classes, educating the students has become even more interesting and enjoyable. These digital classrooms are better known as smart classes, Digischool, HCL, Learner. By following this technology the students are able to understand tough topics. difficult scientific models and mathematical constructions along with their concepts with the help of 2D and 3D visual aids. It also empowers our teachers with a virtual syllabus through which they are able to interact with the students while teaching various interactive tools available in the solution. These digital classes also facilitate to increase the attention span of the students. It is edutainment (education + entertainment) in their classes as through animated characters and cartoons they learn the basics supported by various exercises. In order to make the students understand the practical in their classrooms well, Labs like maths, Science and English language labs are also there.

Project Work (S.U.P.W.)

Project works on different subjects have been introduced in the curriculum to encourage their involvement in extra-curricular activities and to explore their innovative skills.

Class Work and Home Work

Class work includes oral and written work. Class tests are conducted on regular intervals and are taken into consideration for promotion to the next class. Home work in all the subjects is given every day in all classes. Parents are requested to see that the child completes the home work regularly and must sign the home work diary every day.
